

IDEAL TEMPERATURE

- STANDARD FOR HOUSEPLANTS, 65° 80°F
- O DAMAGE LIKELY AT O 50°F 40° TO 30°F
- OTHER like/tolerate cool rather than not
- HUMIDITY
- O NOT PICKY
- O LIKES HUMIDITY
- **ODESN'T LIKE HUMIDITY**
- POSSIBLE PESTS AND PROBLEMS fungal.. problems when too much humidity.



- O LIKES TO BE IN TIGHT/SMALLER POT
- OTHER report every spring.



- WELL BALANCED (STANDARD POTTING MIX)
- O GOOD DRAINAGE (POTTING MIX WITH ADDED PERLITE OR SAND)
- O RETAINS MOISTURE (POTTING MIX WITH ADDED PEAT MOSS)
