

## Therapeutic Horticulture Activity Valentine Flower Petal Banner

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Overview: Gluing flower petals on a cardstock banner with heart shape cut outs

Precautions:

1. Fine motor movement with variation options dependent on the abilities of participants.

Completion Time: 45 - 60 minutes

Materials: (10 participants)

- 1. Banner flags with heart shapes punched out and two circle holes at the top to run a string through to connect flags together (30+)
- 2. Fresh flowers of assorted colors (30+)
- 3. Glue sticks with disappearing color (10)
- 4. 8.5" X11" paper of contrasting color to banner flags (10+) or contrasting table cover (# dependent on how many tables)
- 5. Scissors (1-10)
- 6. String (1 roll)

## Pre-Session Prep:

- 1. Cut banners
- 2. Collect or get fresh flowers; see Tips below if participants' fine motor

dexterity is of concern

- 3. Collect other supplies
- 4. Create an example of finished project

Step-By-Step Process/Instructions:

- 1. Introduce activity and show an example of a finished product.
- 2. Pass out stalks of flowers to each participant.
- 3. Encourage participants to examine a bloom; if appropriate do Mindful Study of a Flower activity, see attached.
- 4. Have participants pull petals off of the flowers; encourage examination of the different colors and gradients on each petal.
- 5. Clear away debris leaving only petals.
- 6. Pass out a piece of paper (if not using contrasting table cover), 3 banners, and a glue stick to each participant.
- 7. Instruct to place a banner flag on contrasting paper
- 8. Rub glue around the cut out shapes, either 1 at a time or more than 1 at a time depending on how quickly they do the next step.
- 9. Place petals over each cut out with the most colorful side down; tearing petals to be small enough to cover one shape as needed.
- 10. Once all cut out shapes are covered with petals, turn the banner flags over.
- 11. If each participant will have an individual banner, pass out string and instruct to thread through the holes of each flag.
- 12. If the flags are to be used together for one long banner, cut one long string and thread each participant's banner.
- 13. Hang the completed banner!

## <u>Tips:</u>

- 1. Do mindful exploration of flowers prior to activity; see attached.
- 2. Collection of seasonal flowers by participants from outside or from pots if possible
- 3. If fine motor dexterity is of concern pull petals off of flowers beforehand leaving at least 1 flower for each participant intact so they can examine and enjoy it.
- 4. Save leftover flower petals to use in other activities either fresh or dried.

- 5. Place any leftover flowers and/or petals in a flower press to use for future sessions.
- 6. Do the activity with other seasonal themes, such as spring, St. Patrick's Day.
